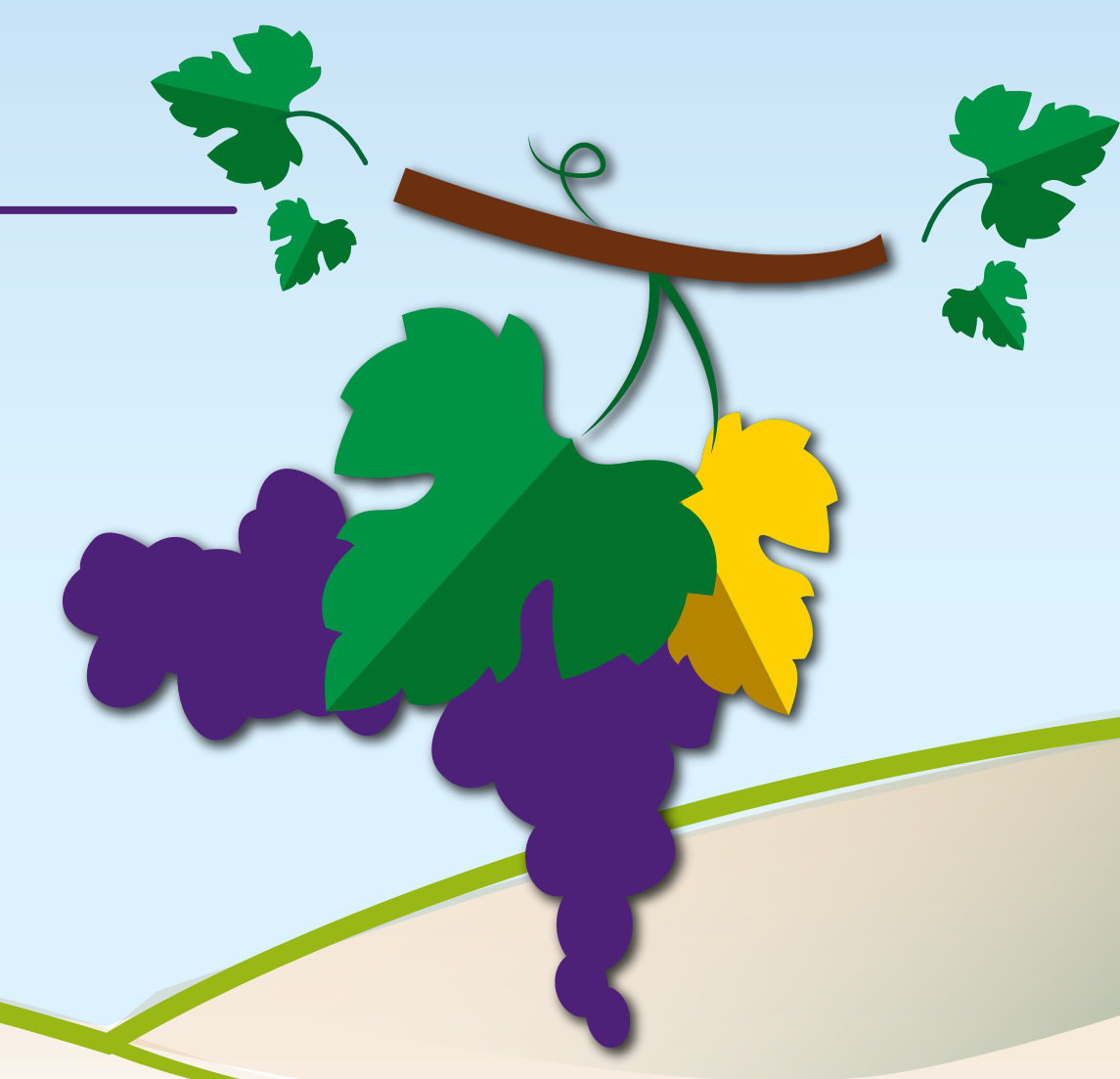
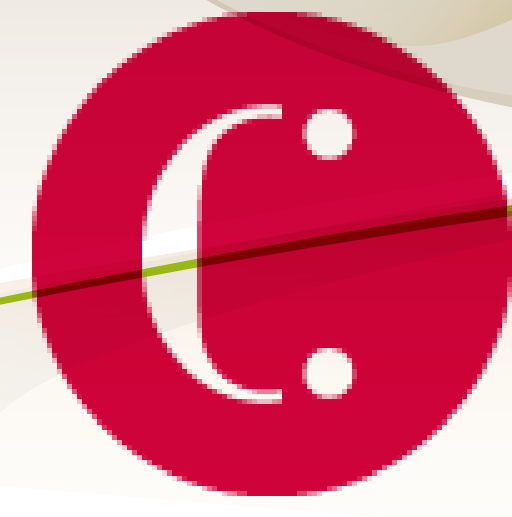

CHIANTI



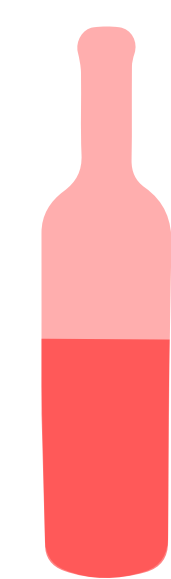

COMPOSITION

Chianti is made from 70% to 100% Sangiovese and other red and white specific grape varieties (no more than 10% white grapes and a maximum of 15% Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon).



CHIANTI CLASSICO



Chianti Classico wine (as normale and riserva) is made in the area between Florence and Siena, known as the Chianti area, specifically in Barberino Val d'Elsa, Castellina in Chianti, Castelnuovo Berardenga, Gaiole in Chianti, Greve in Chianti, Poggibonsi, Radda in Chianti, San Casciano Val di Pesa and Tavarnelle Val di Pesa. On Chianti Classico bottles you can find the black rooster symbol.
